The National Executive Council (NEC) of the Institute on Wednesday 27th June 2018 approved the following additional guidelines and routes for membership in the Institute.

1) EPCI ROUTE FOR QS GRADUATES IN THE MILITARY SERVICE -

All probationers who are either serving or retired military officers and who have either a **BSc/ BTech or HND** in Quantity Surveying who are of the rank of Major and above in the Nigerian Army or its equivalent in the Nigerian Navy and Nigerian Airforce are hereby eligible for the EPCI route:

2) EPCI ROUTE FOR Ph.D. HOLDERS IN QUANTITY SURVEYING

All probationers with Ph.D. in Quantity Surveying, Construction Management, Construction Project Management, Construction Economics, Real Estate/Facilities Management, Built Asset Renewal Management, Construction Engineering and Management and Commercial Management in Construction; **provided their first Degree or HND** is in Quantity Surveying are hereby eligible for the EPCI route:

3) PROBATIONERS, LOGBOOK & DIARIES FOR FRESH GRADUATES

All graduates with BSc/ BTech or HND in Quantity Surveying are eligible to obtain probationer membership forms. Eligible candidates may wish to apply for their probationer membership of the institute and commence filling their Log books and Diaries **without presenting their NYSC discharge certificate.**

4) REGISTRATION OF PRACTICE FIRMS

All qualified corporate members wishing to register a practice firm are hereby to note that registration of firms is not limited to sole proprietorships/ Business name, but is open to limited liability companies under the CAMA; provided always that the majority shares are held by a corporate member of the Institute.
