It is a condition for inclusion that the author (or at least one of them in the case of a joint submission) registers for the Conference.

All papers are expected to address specific areas of impact of the Construction Industry on National Development and Economy, special consideration will be given to innovative concepts drawing from experiences in different climes, future knowledge areas and opportunities for the construction sector.
