Nomination Form for National Executive Council (NEC) Election of the Institute

I am pleased to forward herewith the Nomination Form for election into the National Executive Council of the Nigerian Institute of Quantity Surveyors for your necessary action. The election is billed to take place on Saturday 21st November, 2015 during the Biennial General Meeting at Lagos Oriental Hotel, Victoria Island, Lagos.

In accordance with Articles 12.3 of The Nigerian Institute of Quantity Surveyors 2014 Constitution (2nd Amendment 2015), election shall take place at the venue decided by the NEC to elect the following officers of the Institute:

1. Deputy President
2. Vice President
3. Secretary General
4. Assistant Secretary General
5. Treasurer
6. Secretary - Professional Development and Library
7. Secretary - Marketing and Corporate Affairs
8. Secretary - International Affairs

Please note that only **Qualified Financial Members (Fellow and Members) who have paid fully their subscriptions as at 16th of October, 2015 in accordance with clause 1.4 (ii) of the First Schedule of the NIQS Constitution can vote and/or be voted for.** Specifically, member's attention is hereby called to the Provisions of Articles 6.2.5 (i-iv) and Article 1.6 (i-ii) of the First Schedule to wit:

Article 6.2.5:

- i. Fellows, with not less than Fifteen (15) years post MNIQS qualification, who must have served the Institute in NEC for a minimum of Two (2) terms as elected member, or one term as elected member in addition to being a previous Chairman of a Chapter or a National Body/Committee, or has served the Institute as Vice President shall be eligible to contest for the office of the Deputy President.
- ii. Fellows, with not less than Twelve (12) years post MNIQS qualification, who must have served the Institute in NEC for a minimum of ONE (1) term as elected member,

or served as Chairman of a Chapter, or has served in a National Body/Committee for at least Six years, shall be eligible to contest for the office of the Vice President.

- iii. Save for 6.2.5 (i-ii) above (Deputy President & Vice President), Members with not less than Five (5) years post MNIQS qualification and election, who must have served in a National Body/Committee, or the Executive Committee of a chapter, shall be eligible to contest for office in the NEC.
- iv. In all cases, Members contesting for elective positions in the NEC shall each be duly registered as members of a chapter; and must have attended and or participated in at least 60% of the activities of a committee and/or chapter in any given 12 months.

Article 1.6 of the First Schedule:

- i. Candidates shall draw up manifestos based on the Fundamental Objectives of the Institute pursuant to **Article 2.0** of this Constitution.
- ii. Prior to the commencement of voting, all the contestant for the offices of (a) Deputy President, (b) Vice President, (c) Secretary-General, shall each address the voting audience and answer any questions by the audience on their manifestos.


