

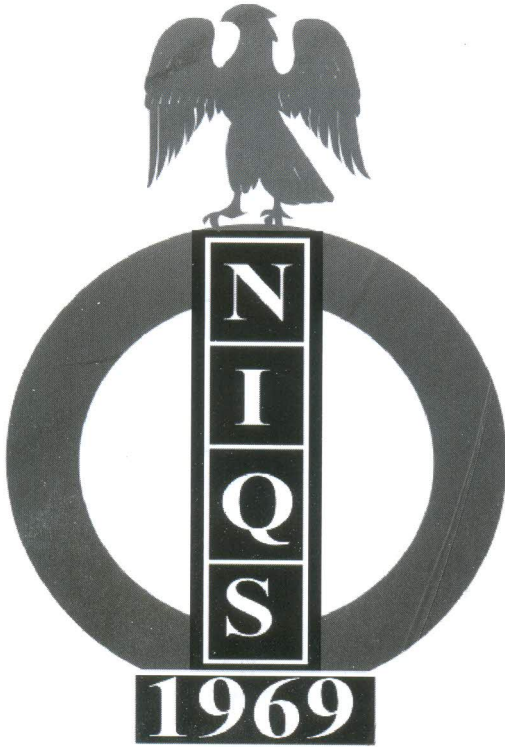

PREAMBLE

The Rules and Guidelines to Professional Examinations of the Institute was last reviewed in October 2002. Since then there has been several policies in respect to the Institute's Examinations and Qualifications.

This present review addresses the need to capture all these policies into a single reference document. The Education and Training Committee undertook the review and the major thrusts are:

1. The annual assessment of Dairies & Logbooks of work experience as against the previous 3 years submissions at a go.
2. A pass in Dairies & Logbooks being a requirement before sitting for any stage of the written examinations.
3. The PCI will be based on the work experience recorded in stage 3 of the Dairies & Logbooks of the candidates.
4. The EPCI route has been introduced. The criteria have been properly defined and articulated which will culminate in the Experienced Professional Competence Interview.

It is hoped that the content of this Rules and Guidelines to Professional Examinations and Qualifications will go a long way in improving the efficiency of the examination and also the quality of qualification obtained thereon.
