

## A. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR EXPERIENCED ROUTE CANDIDATES

Prospective candidates must have/attain the under listed qualifications/requirements to be eligible for the Experienced Candidates' Examination/Interview:

1	<b>ACADEMIC QUALIFICATIONS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Five (5) Credits at G.C.E O-Level or SSCE/Equivalent which must include English, Mathematics and Physics.</li> <li>ii. HND, and/or a degree in Quantity Surveying from an Institution accredited by QSRBN</li> </ul>
2	<b>EXPERIENCE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Post graduate practical experience in Quantity Surveying related duties and functions must not be less than Ten (10) years as at the time of submitting the application.</li> </ul>
3	<b>CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT (CPD)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Evidence of 60 CPD points out of which 20 must have been obtained within the last five (5) years preceding the date of application</li> <li>ii. In the alternative, applicant shall show evidence of having attended Approved Training Course/Module from the QS Academy.</li> <li>iii. Evidence of active involvement at the Chapter's level including financial contributions to the activities of the Institute</li> </ul>
4	<b>RECORD OF PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Candidates shall submit a Report of their activities in the last 10 years giving details of QS and QS related duties/functions they carried out or participated in and an essay/critical analysis of a QS or QS activity they undertook; MSc and PhD research carried out, etc - the Report should state challenges encountered, lessons learnt etc. The Report must be of a minimum of 2500 words but not more than 3500 words and must be endorsed by the Candidates' Superior in their respective Establishment.</li> </ul>
5	<b>PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATIONS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. If successful, the Candidate shall be required to write in full the Test of Professional Competence (TPC) Examinations and thereafter sit for the Professional Competence Interview (PCI)</li> </ul>
6	<b>APPLICATION FEE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Application Fee shall be as approved by the National Executive Council from time to time and must be paid in full and the evidence submitted together with the Application Form.</li> </ul>
