QS Mafimidiwo, Bamidele Adeniyi hails from Ijebu North-East local government of Ogun State, Nigeria. He attended the then University of Ife, Ile Ife (now Obafemi Awolowo University, Ile-Ife) where he bagged his Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) degree in Quantity Surveying in 1986. He is currently running M.Phil./Ph.D. degree at the University of Lagos, Akoka, Lagos.

He is a Fellow of the Nigerian Institute of Quantity Surveyors (FNIQS) and a Registered Quantity Surveyor by the Quantity Surveyors Registration board of Nigeria (QSRBN) since 1990.
